THE TIRED MAN

Flemming Lassen designed the overstuffed armchair, The Tired Man, in 1935 for the Cabinetmakers' Guild Exhibition. According to Flemming Lassen himself, the aim of the chair was for the person sitting in it to feel "like a polar bear cub held by its mother in the middle of the ice cap feeling warm and safe."

By Lassen relaunched the Tired Man in 2015 to great acclaim with the chair going onto win the award for 'comeback of the year' at the Danish Design Awards. As a direct extension of the chair, by Lassen launched the Tired Man Footstool, which references the same lines and curves as the seat of the Tired Man armchair. The new Footstool also reuses the same wheels and legs as the main armchair.
