Materials, Process and Finishing

Handmade in Denmark, the production process combines Brdr. Krüger's highly skilled joinery techniques with modern technology, ensuring precision and lasting quality. Each piece is meticulously hand-sanded in gradual steps to achieve a soft, tactile finish, and treated with a clear oil that enhances the wood's durability while preserving its natural repairability.

Fumed Oak Process

For a deeper tone, the oak undergoes a traditional fuming process, where it is exposed to a small amount of ammonia vapors in a sealed environment for 20 hours. This reaction with the wood's natural tannins enhances the grain structure and deepens the color. As a natural, non-surface-based treatment, no dyes are used, preserving the wood's authentic character. Variations in hue may occur depending on the tannin content of each piece.

Craftsmanship Statement

We support and foster the Danish cultural heritage of craftsmanship by preserving and advancing the traditional techniques nurtured in our family workshop since 1886. This commitment reflects both the preservation of the craft and its evolution through the integration of new techniques, innovation, and design development.
